Loving Community

Hope & Empathy

Offer hope and empathy. Leave advice giving, unless guidance/information was explicitly requested.

Make space, take space

Make space for those who have not been heard; take space if you haven't been heard.

Confidentiality

Observe confidentiality: Lessons belong to the listener, stories to the storyteller.

Reflection Questions

Reflection for 3 minutes: use any of these to prompt your memory of what you learned about money.

When you were very young, what do you remember about what the adults around you said about money? What do you remember about what they did with money?

Did people talk about money where you grew up? What did they say?

Was there something taught in school or blasted in entertainment media that ingrained some beliefs about money?







Add circles for each person clustered by projects.










Learn how 'brights spots' work with your systems
